

Photography and filming guidelines (excluding wedding photography)

Due to colourful lush surroundings, city views and stunning outlooks Roma Street Parkland is a popular setting for both filming and photo shoots. Roma Street Parkland Management considers all requests on an individual basis and whilst appreciating opportunities to showcase the Parkland we also have a responsibility to ensure that the impact on visitors and nearby residents is kept to a minimum.

Roma Street Parkland should be notified of all film and all commercial photo shoots excluding wedding photography prior to the shoot. If your shoot is of a non-commercial nature (for example small scale student shoots) then you may still need complete and lodge an application form and state on the application that its for a educational or non-commercial purpose.

You must contact the Parkland Administration Office two weeks prior to the shoot on 07 3006 4545 if your shoot involves or requires any of the following:

- access to power
- vehicles on site
- closure of public areas
- use of generators or other noise generating appliances
- lighting, dolly tracks, cables running across public areas or unattended equipment.

Please note that fees may apply.

Conditions of all photography and filming

Approvals/applications: each application for a non-commercial photo and film shoot is assessed on an individual basis. Approval is subject to the nature of the shoot requested and availability. You will be required to complete the application form.

Public liability insurance: it may be a condition of our approval that we require you to hold a public liability insurance policy. We will make a decision about this based upon issues like the size and nature of the shoot and the equipment you intend to bring into the Parkland.

Cleanliness: if your application is approved, you will be required to keep the area you use clean and tidy at all times during the shoot. All access ways are also to be kept clear.

Additional cleaning: any cleaning required over and above our standard operational cleaning will incur a charge.

Multi-location shoots: if you require the use of multiple locations you will need to provide us with specific details regarding the locations you require and the nature of the shoot.

Things we do not allow

- Approaching Roma Street Parkland staff and visitors
- Photographs or film to be taken of any child or adult engaged in a private act
- Alterations to Parkland horticulture, fixtures and fittings
- Building or erecting a structure with out prior approval
- Use of power supply without prior approval
- Interference with Parkland plants and animals
- Lighting keeping or using fires
- Use of pyrotechnics
- Possessing or using an appliance such as a firearm or replica firearm
- Roma Street Parkland reserves the right to refuse the permission for any photography or filming within the Parkland.
